Teaching Sustainable Goals

Objective:

Students will be able to identify and explain Sustainable Goals, learn new vocabulary related to sustainability, and participate in group discussions on the topic.

Key Points:

- Definition of Sustainable Goals
- New Vocabulary: sustainability, renewable, conservation
- Importance of Sustainable Goals in protecting the environment

Opening:

- Introduce the topic of Sustainable Goals by asking students: "Why is it important to protect our environment for future generations?"
- Watch a short video on Sustainable Goals to capture students' interest and set the context.
- (<u>Video</u>)

Guided Practice:

- Define Sustainable Goals and discuss their importance Set of cards in Quizzlet
- Engage students in activity where they have to match Sustainable Goals with their descriptions with a game of <u>Blooket</u>
- Introduce new vocabulary: sustainability, renewable, conservation.

Group work:

• In groups, students will create a poster in Canva app showcasing one Sustainable Goal and suggesting ways to achieve it in their community.

Closing:

- Have each group present their poster and summarize the Sustainable Goal they chose and their proposed solutions.
- Ask students to reflect on what they have learned about Sustainable Goals during the lesson.

Assessment:

Students will be assessed through a group discussion where they need to identify and explain at least three Sustainable Goals and use the new vocabulary learned during the lesson.
