Catherine Parr was Henry's last and sixth wife and he was her third husband; the pair were married in 1543. She was the daughter of a lady-in-waiting to Henry's first wife, Catherine of Aragon. She was named after the queen; thus (**stoga*) Henry's last wife was named after his first. Catherine Parr was independent and very intelligent.

Catherine enjoyed a close relationship with Henry's three children, Mary, Elizabeth and Edward. She was personally involved in the education of Elizabeth and Edward.

She helped restore Henry's daughters Mary and Elizabeth to the line of succession to the throne before Henry's death.
