Jane Seymour



Jane Seymour (1509 - 1537), king Henry's third wife, was born to a wealthy family. They owned 100 manors (*plemićka kuća) in 19 countries and five castles. She wasn't well educated, she only knew how to read and write her own name, she was proficient in household tasks and other hobbies, such as gardening and needlework (*vezenje).

Henry married Jane only 11 days after he had his second wife executed. In 1537, she gave birth to Henry VIII's first male heir, King Edward VI, the future king of England. She died of childbirth complications less than two weeks later, after having been queen for only a year and a half.

Jane was the only wife buried with him in the same tomb (*grobnica) after his death.
