• A **spoof** is a deception like the BBC documentary about flying penguins or a parody like the comedy series *The Office*.

The first famous spoof was a programme on Halloween in 1938. Orson Welles, the famous director and actor, adapted H.G. Well's story *The War of the Worlds* for the radio.

He introduced the play first but the rest of it sounded like real live radio with interruptions for new bulletins about the Martian invasion of the Earth.

Thousands of listeners were tricked and frightened because they thought it was real.
